Position title: Cashier

- Process transactions on the cash register

Skills needed

- Ability to use a cash register, credit card machine, and adding machine or a desire to learn
- Ability to remain calm, flexible and efficient
- Standing for 1-2 hours at a time
- Keen eyesight
- Accuracy and attention to detail
- Ability to bend and stoop to show customers jewelry from the jewelry case

Commitment

- One 2-4 hour shift per week or every other week with a minimum commitment of 3 months
